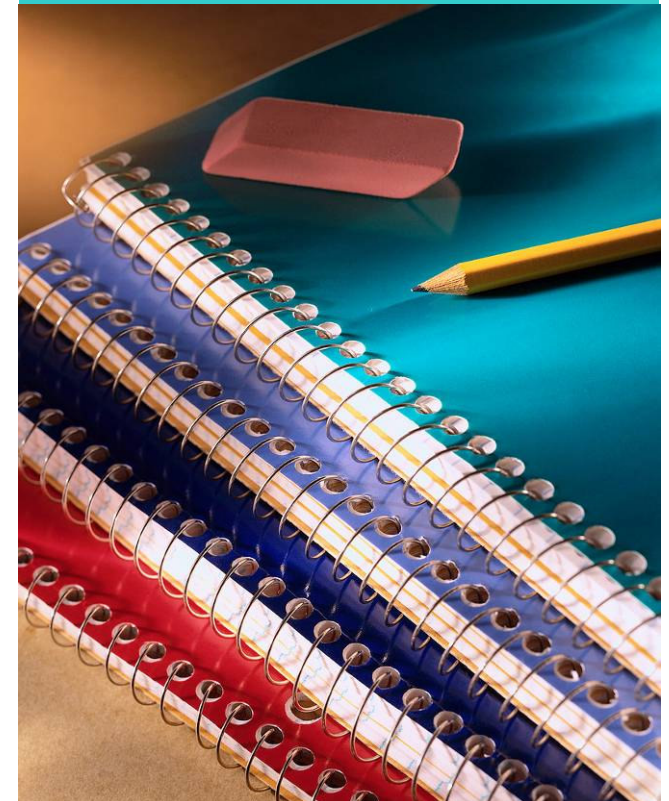

Students who worked for one of the above noted properties during the 2009 season and is currently enrolled in a post secondary program at a university or community college in one of the following multi-year programs:

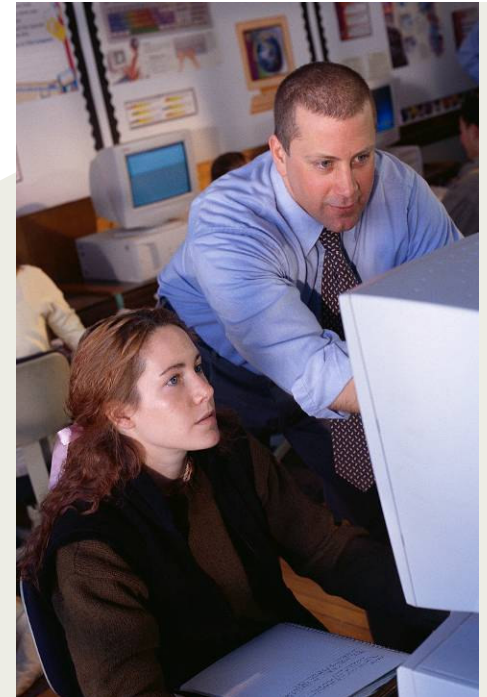
- Tourism / Hospitality Management
